Here are just a few of the projects that have recently been completed:





The maintenance crew spent several days tunneling under roadways to get communication and power lines connected to the new security gates.



In January, there were a total of 333 active work orders submitted. The crew completed 309 (92.7%) of those work orders. 71 of those work orders were preventative maintenance jobs and 24 work orders are still currently active. There were 6 duplicates and 44 declined due to special circumstance.
