• Explicit Instruction

- We continue to define the work for this year. We had an explicit instruction Leadership meeting on Oct. 17 and we determined that we will encourage coaching discussions between our internal coach's and our teachers with an emphasis between now and Christmas break on giving opportunities to respond and everyone does everything. One goal for each teacher is to video tape themselves teaching one 10 minutes time block with their lesson utilizing the emphasis areas of opportunities to respond and everyone does everything.
