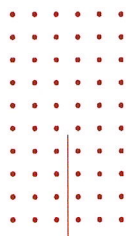
2025 District Highlights

- Science Proficiency
 - 97% in comparison to all districts in the state
- ELA Proficiency
 - 94% in comparison to all districts in the state
- Math Proficiency
 - 92% in comparison to all districts in the state
- Math Growth Percentile
 - Grew 12 percentage points from last year
- Increased # of students taking (passing) Algebra I
- Increased gains for students who receive IEP services in ELA + Math (+3)

- D70 is above state + comparison group average



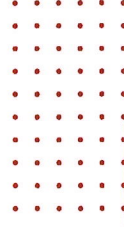

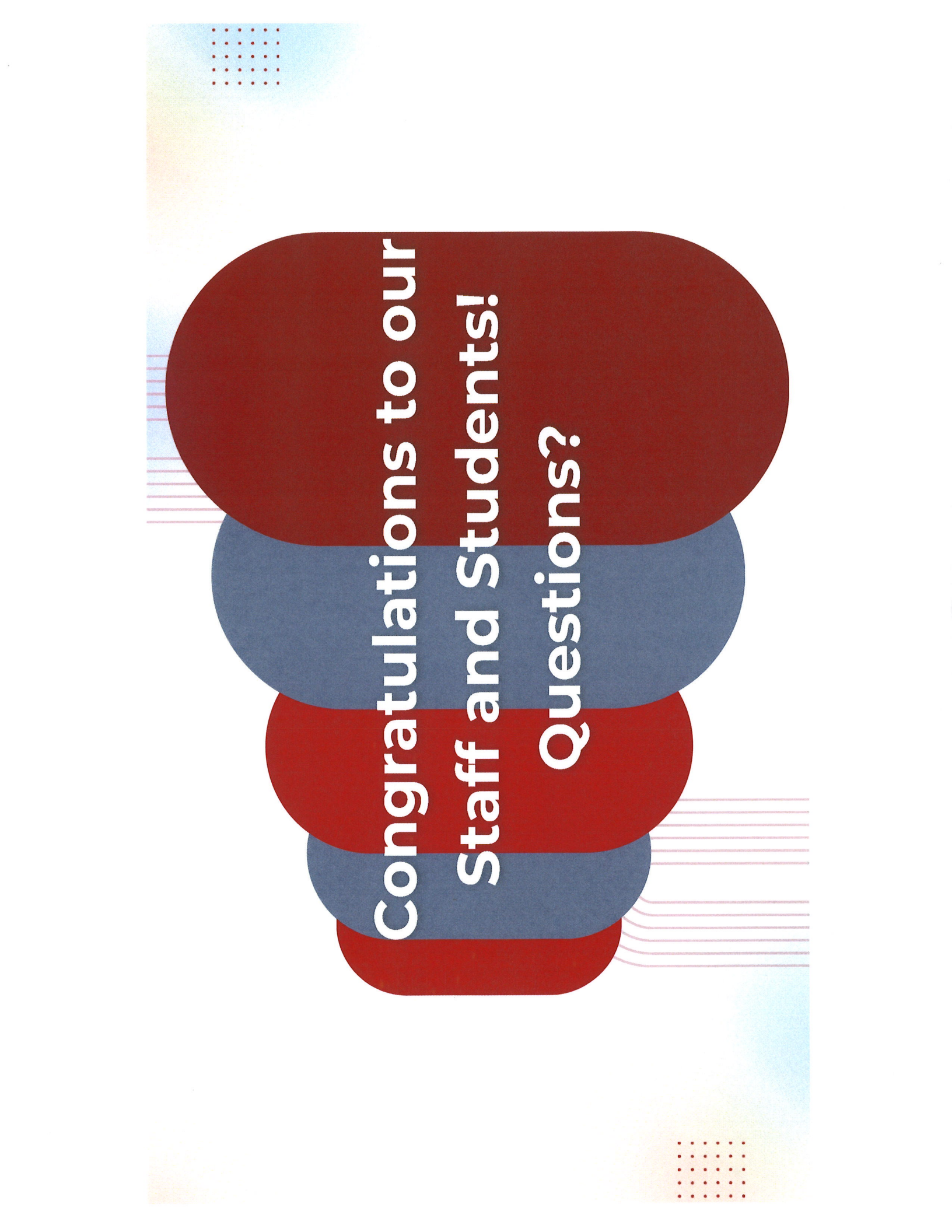

Figure 1. Proficiency Distribution of Illinois Districts - ELA

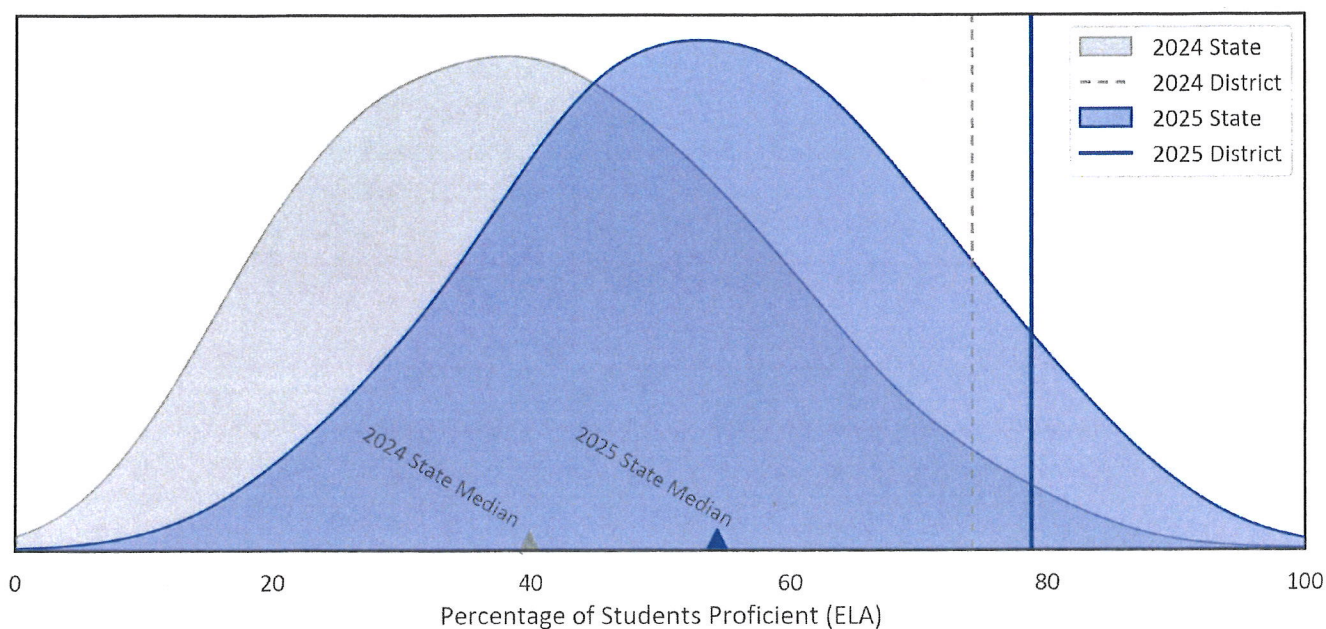


Figure 2. Proficiency Distribution of Illinois Districts - Math

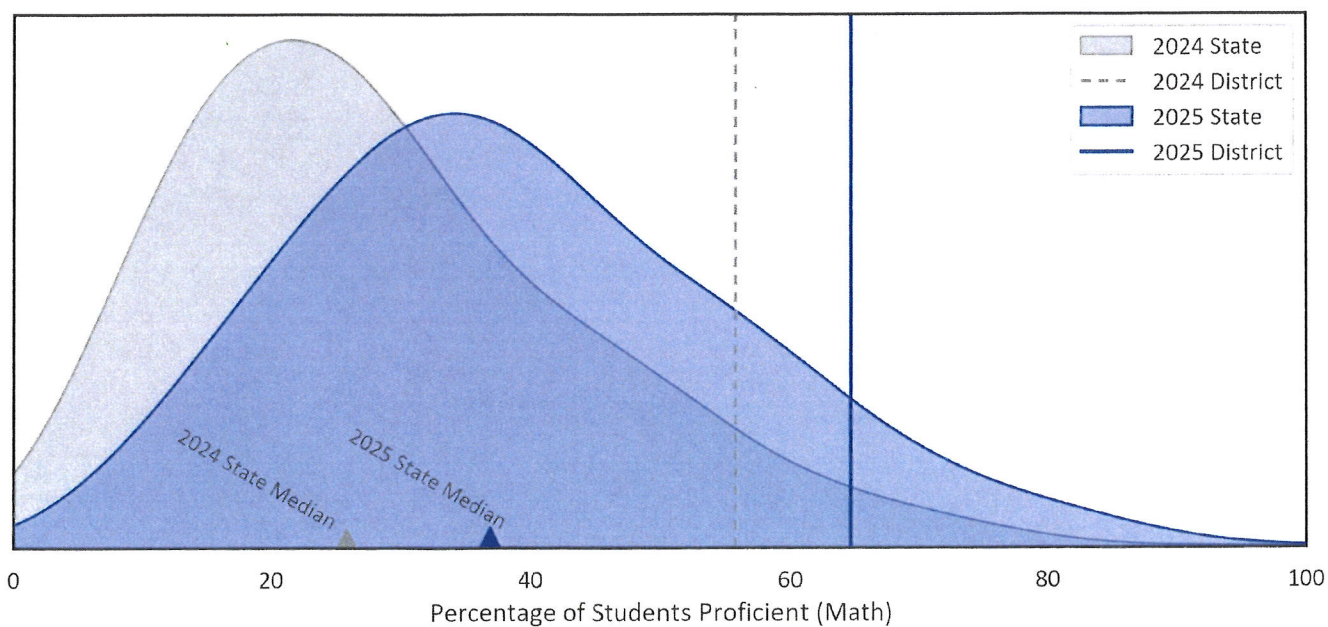


Figure 1: Percent Proficient on Illinois State Tests - ELA

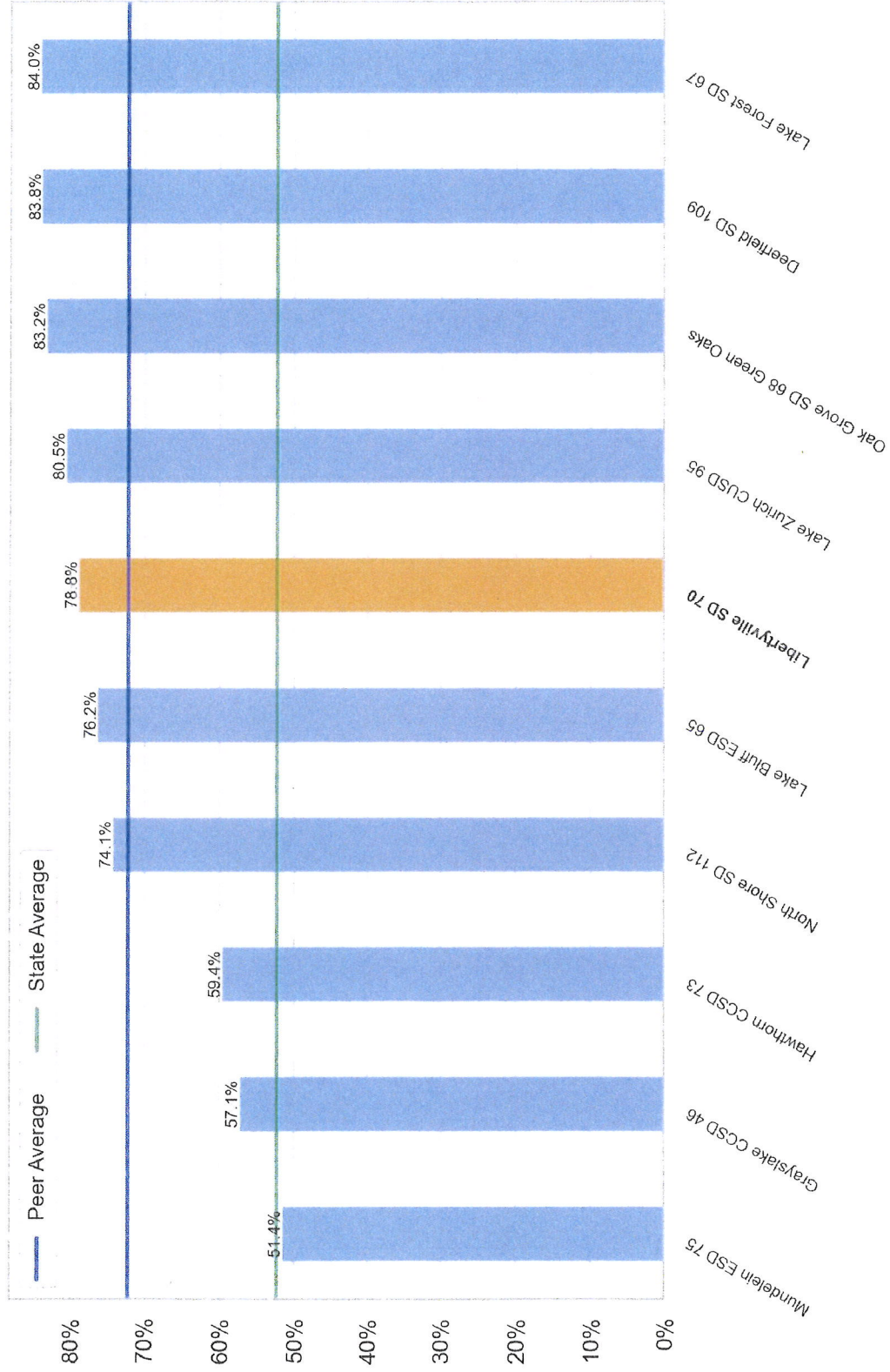


Figure 2: Percent Proficient on Illinois State Tests - Mathematics

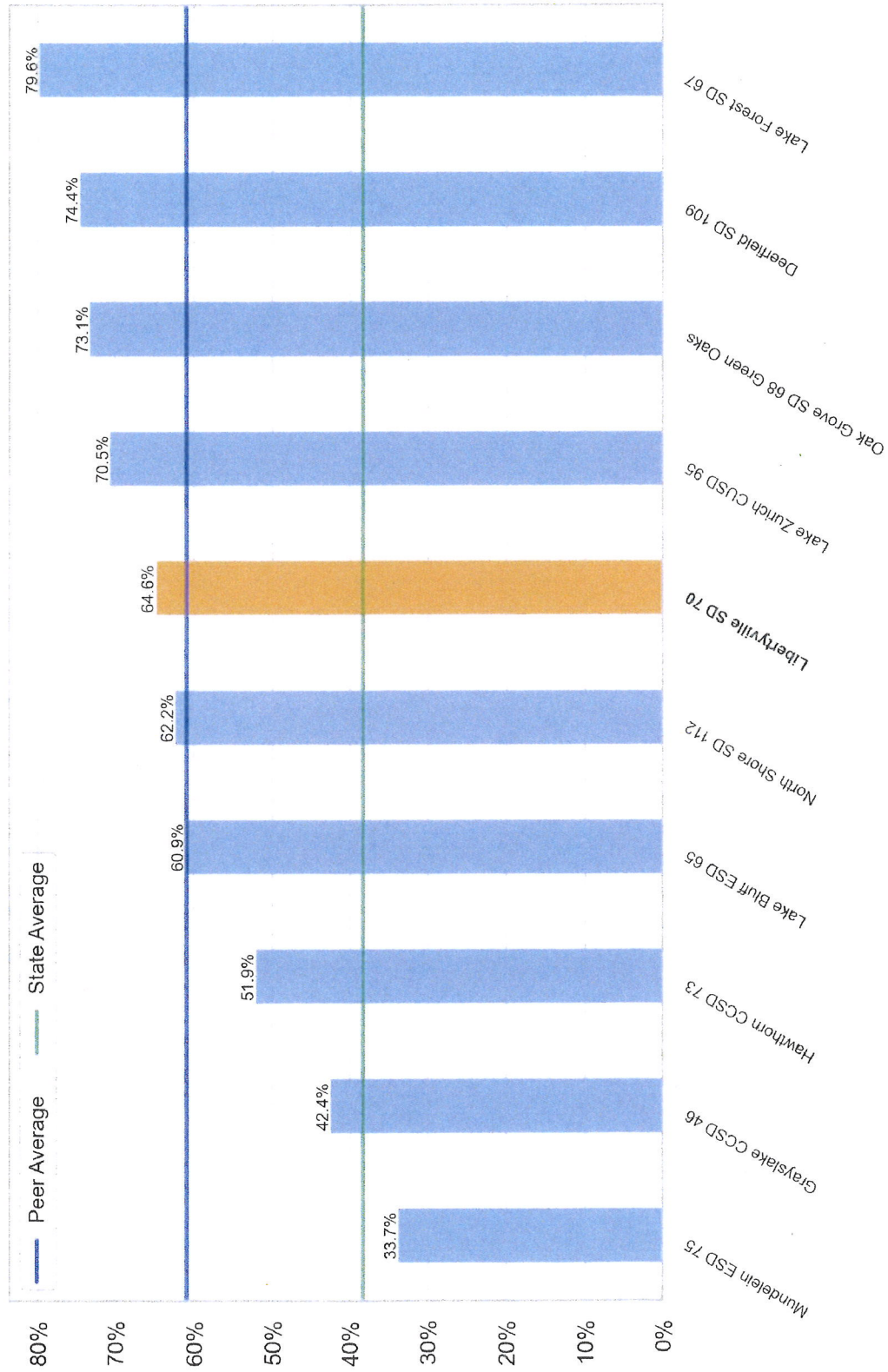


Figure 3: Percent Proficient on Illinois State Tests - Science

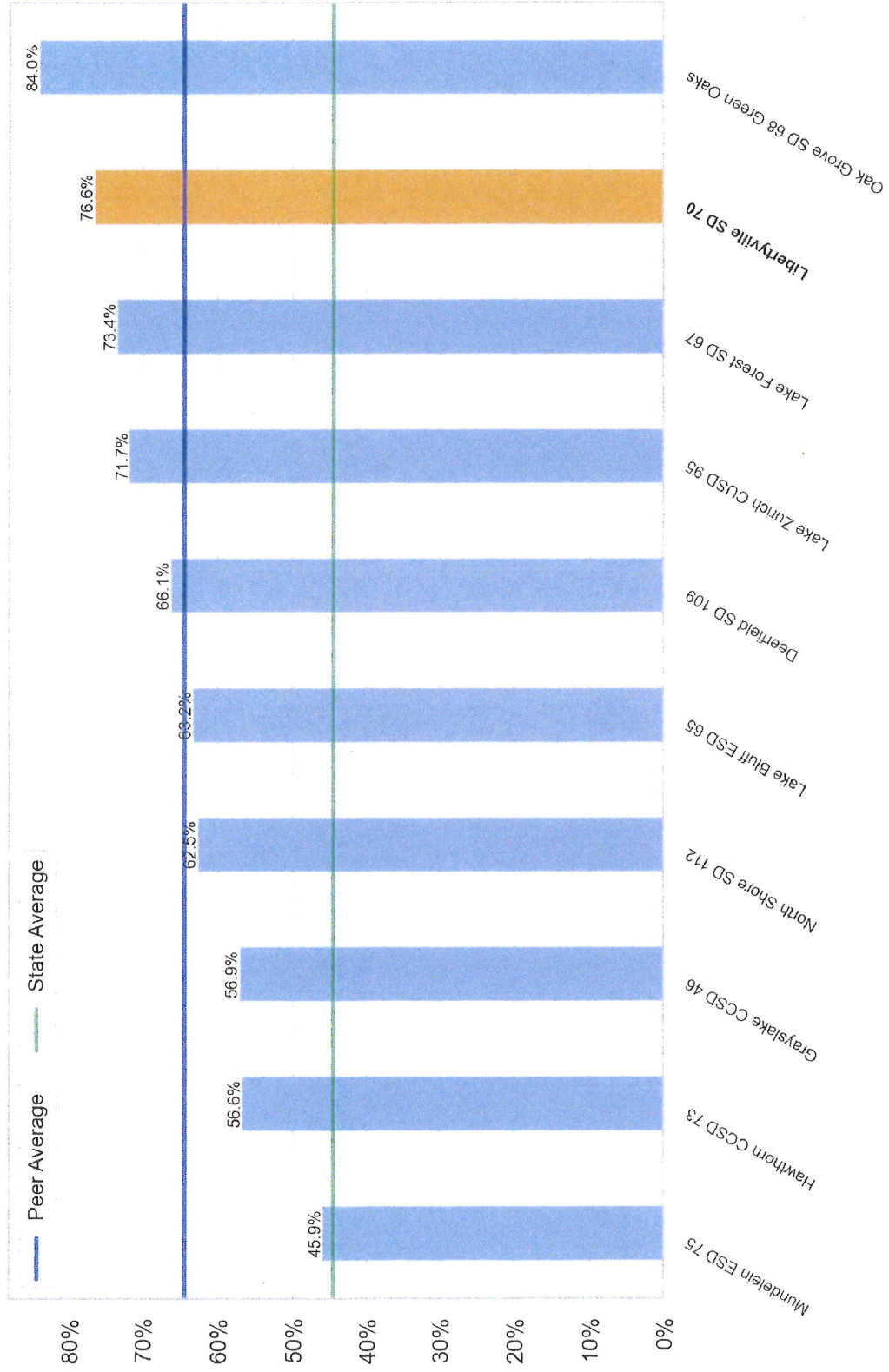


Figure 4: Instructional Spending Per Pupil vs. ELA Percent Proficient

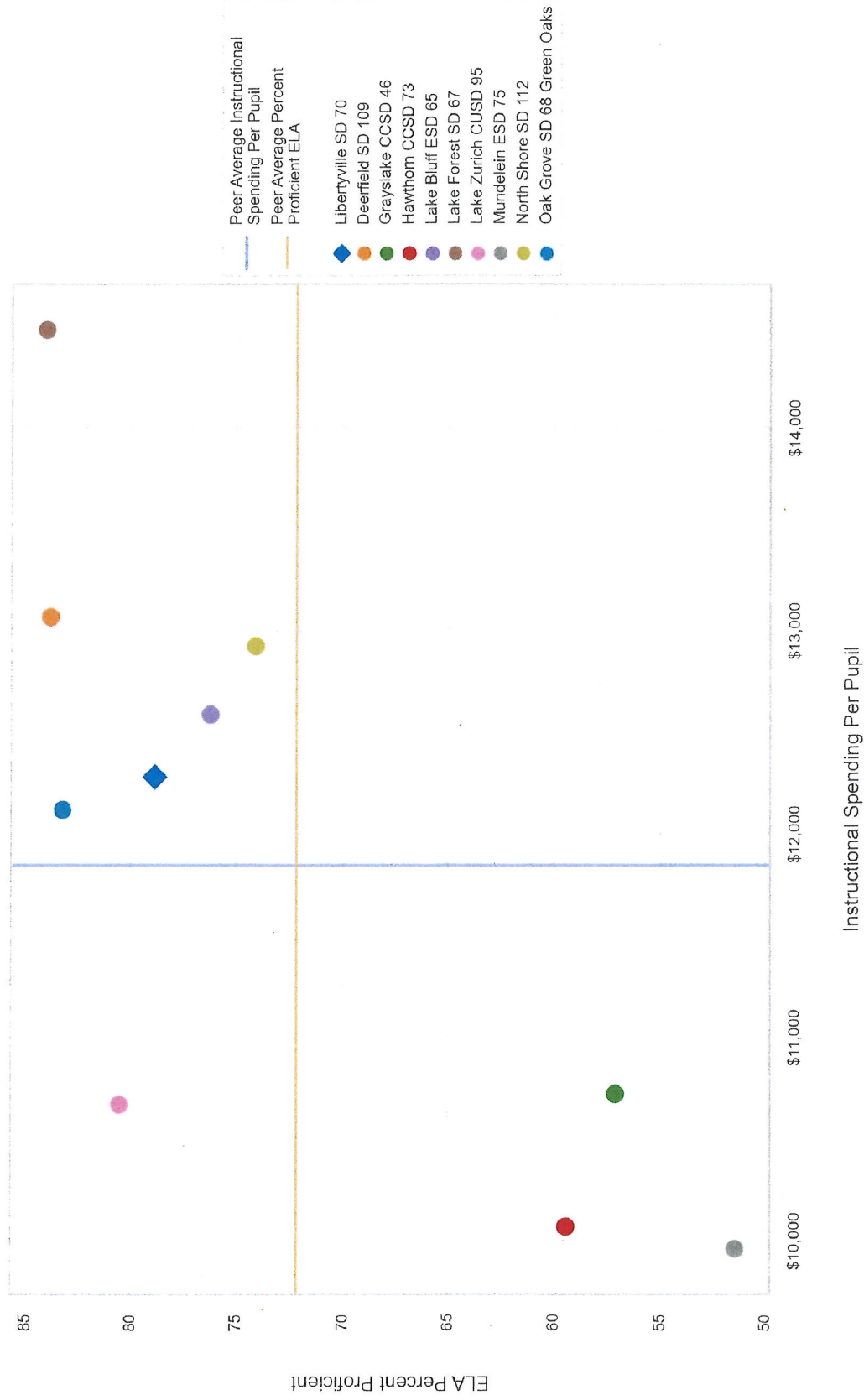


Figure 5: Instructional Spending Per Pupil vs. Mathematics Percent Proficient

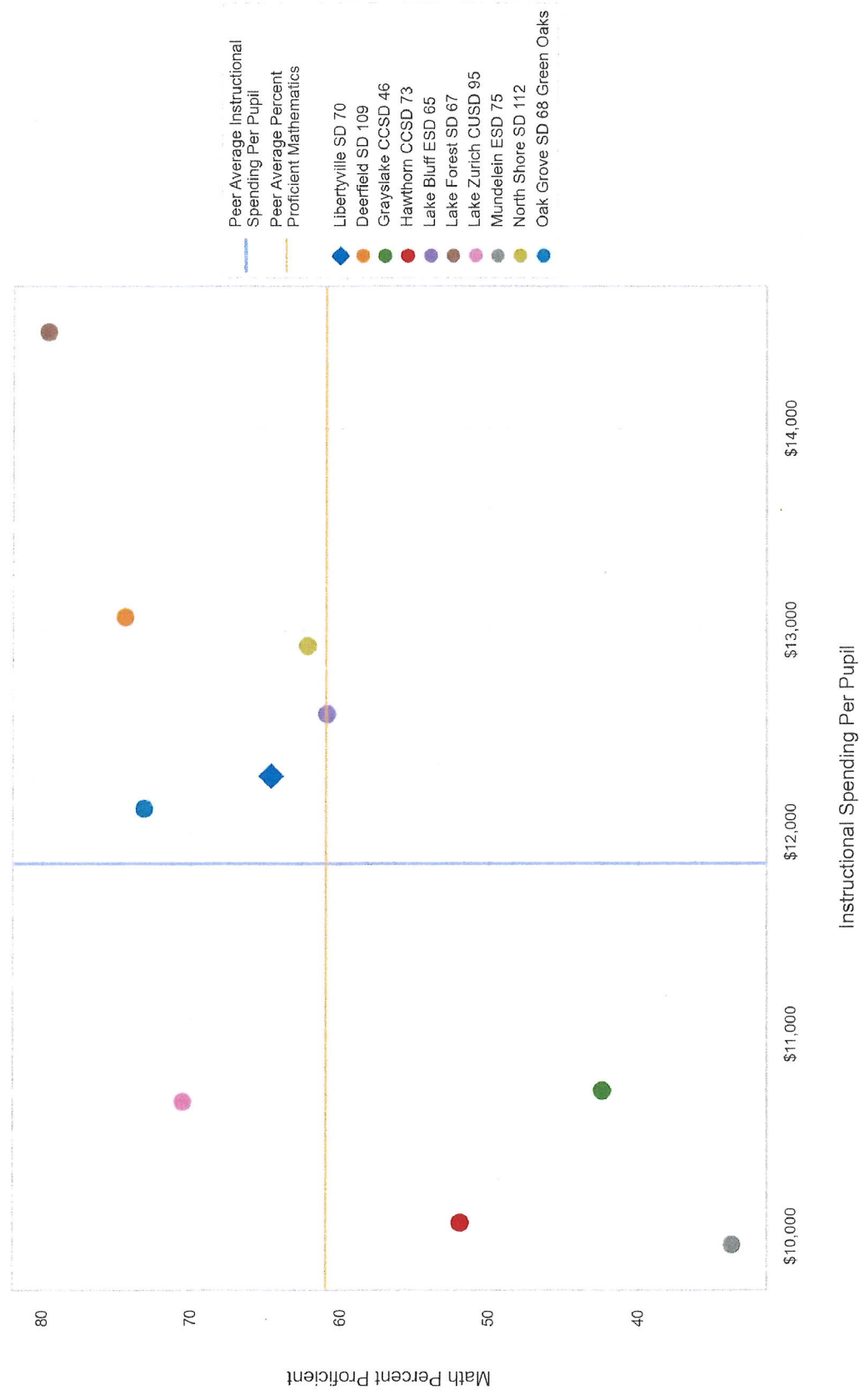


Figure 6: Instructional Spending Per Pupil vs. Science Percent Proficient
