AGENDA ITEM: Final Update on Summer Maintenance Projects

ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S): Financial/Facilities – The District shall exhibit excellence in financial and facility planning, management, and stewardship.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- During the May and June board meetings, a number of summer maintenance projects were discussed with the Board of Trustees. The largest of these projects pertained to the deferred maintenance needs at the seventh grade section of Aledo Middle School.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATIONS:

- Renovation work at the seventh grade section of Aledo Middle School is virtually completed. Ceiling grid has been replaced and new ceiling tile has been installed. Retrofitting the restrooms with replacement partitions, sinks, lights, and mirrors has been completed. Painting has been completed in all areas with a portion of the “Bearcat Den” (cafeteria) remaining. The remaining facelift items to be completed in the “Bearcat Den” will be finalized after the start of school.
- Painting inside the Multi-Purpose Center has been completed.
- Twelve (12) A/C rooftop units have been replaced at Aledo Middle School.
- Turf replacement at the Middle School Stadium has been completed. The interior fencing adjacent to the playing field has been removed. Plans are being finalized for replacement of the scoreboard and the exterior fencing between the field house and restrooms. Additionally, consideration is being given to re-surfacing the walkways and common areas.
- Interior painting at Coder Elementary School has been completed.
- The new lighting system for the High School Auditorium has been installed by Aledo ISD staff. Technicians from the company the system was purchased from have completed their inspection and certified the final results.
- Normal summer preventative maintenance items such as replacement of filters, etc. has been completed.
