Each Spring the school board approves a set number of transfers in from other school districts for the upcoming school year. This past year, 150 slots were approved. I would like to recommend we close the remaining 66 open slots for this school year. We would still take students that meet transfer requirements for hardship as well as students that might move out of the distirct and want to stay with TRSD for the remainder of the year.			
Provide history/background information on your proposal. Given our current class sizes and not having any transfer requests in the last few weeks. I am recommending closing our last remaining open slots.			
List the advantages of your proposal: This procedure follows the interdistrict transfer laws and policies and allows us as much flexibility to meet student/building needs as possible. At this time of the school year, the vast majority of classes have settled, and routines have been taught and established. We believe it is in the best interest of current students and staff to close IDT slots at this time. We will still be able to accept and process both Remainder of the Year and Hardship requests.
