## **Food Service Building Report**

The Food Service Program total meals served for Summer Food Program for the month of August 2025 are below;

SNP:

Breakfast: 9,789 (7 days of meals) Lunch: 6,396 meals (7 days of meals)

SFSP:

Breakfast: 50 meals (8 days of meals) Lunch: 2, 490 meals (8 days of meals)

The Food Service Program is in full swing with school back in session for the academic year 2025-2026. And, the Supper Program has started on September 2<sup>nd</sup> and is serving Monday-Friday from 4:30pm-7:00pm at the Napi Cafeteria.

The head cooks and (1) warehouse clerk in each bps kitchen is now certified is first aid cpr/aed which will ensure safety for student and staff in each cafeteria and warehouse.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail. And, the copy center is now complete. The copy center has had a window put in and a walk way between the mail room and copy center.

The food service program does have vacancies; (1) assistant cook at Supper Program, and (1) assistant cook at BHS kitchen.

The food service staff will be participating in an indigenous foods/Culinary training on October 17<sup>th</sup> which will be held at the new warehouse. The training is in collaboration with Team Nutrition, FAST Blackfeet, and Mariah Gladstone (Indikitchen). We are looking forward to incorporating Indigenous recipes into the Supper Program Menu.
