Each year, I provide an update to the Board and public as to the progress being made toward the successful completion of my performance goals. Those goals were approved at the September 25th Regular Meeting.

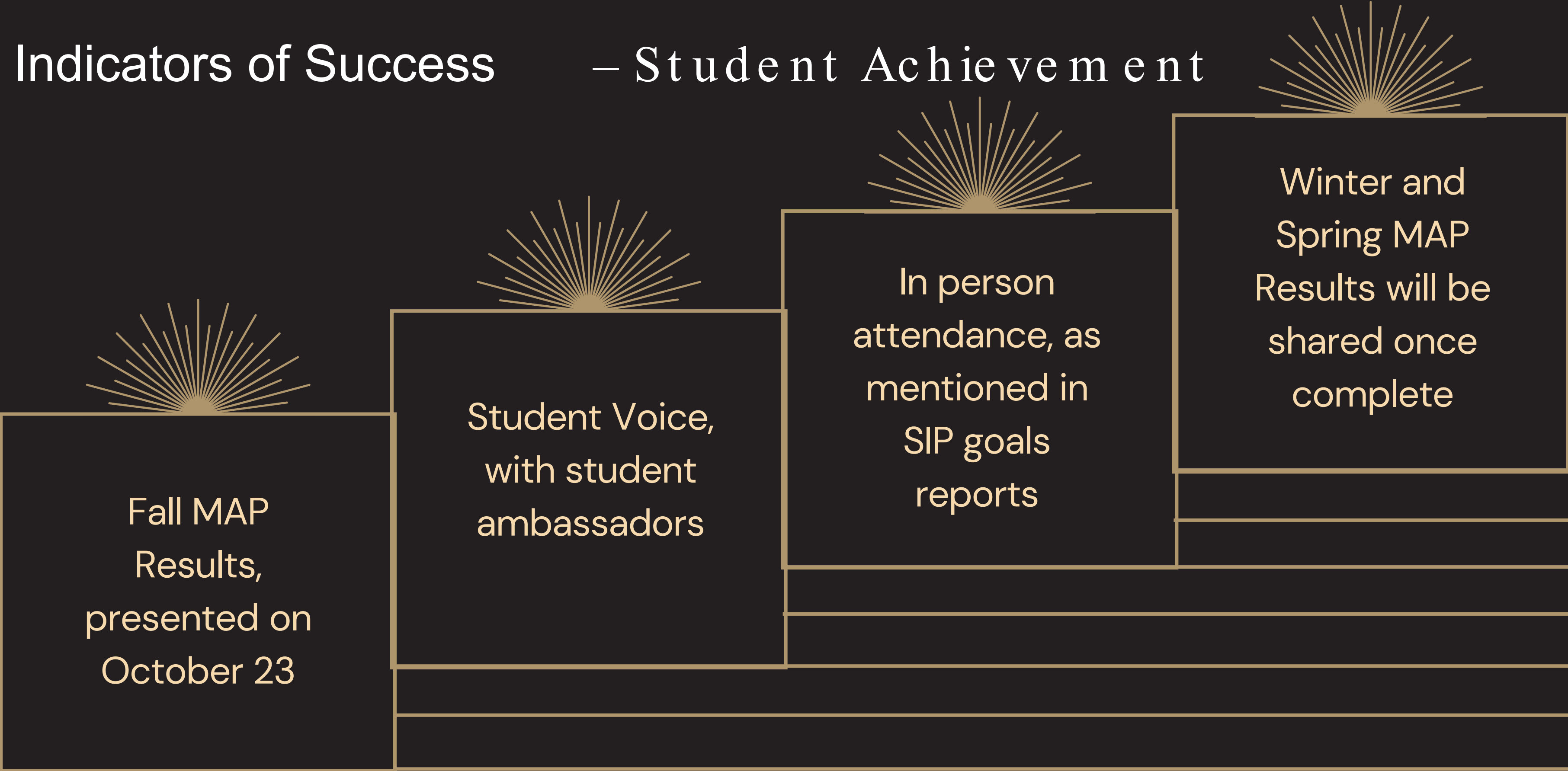
