 - i. Missing AK Statute and report card to the public statement in the references; updated inclusivity verbiage

 - ii. 1st Update: This update provides the Superintendent greater discretion to dispose of used District property, in an amount up to \$5,000 and the addition of "federal" law.
 - **iii.** 2nd Update: This update provides that surplus equipment purchased with a federal fund in the amount of \$5,000 or greater must be disposed of in accordance with federal Uniform Administrative Requirements.
 - iv. Topics separate by Federal fund section headers
 - d. MEMO 24-119 → BP 3311 Bids
 - i. Administrative Services to draft an Administrative Regulation (AR)
 - **ii.** Administrative Services to add an Exhibit (E) with a sole source statement.

 - e. MEMO 24-120 → BP 3541.1 School-related Trips
 - i. This update raises the recommended amount of private insurance for persons transporting students to \$1,000,000. It also revises the school-related trip section to ensure that trips in school vans are covered by policy.
 - f. MEMO 24-121 → BP 3590 Electronic Signatures **NEW POLICY**
 - i. This policy establishes guidelines for how to utilize and accept electronic signatures in business, noninstructional, and instructional settings.

g. MEMO 24-122 → BP 4222 Classified Personnel - Teacher Aides - Paraprofessionals

i. This update revises various board policies and administrative regulations to reference and incorporate BP 5141.42, Professional Boundaries for staff and students. The changes cross-reference BP 5141.42 and, where appropriate, state that applicable training required by BP 5141.42 shall be provided.

h. MEMO 24-123 → BP 5124.1 Family Engagement – *NEW POLICY*

i. This new board policy and administrative regulation address family engagement and efforts districts should take to coordinate with parents. The policy and regulation are broad based and may be edited based on specific district need.

i. MEMO 24-124 → BP-5131.9 Academic Honesty

i. This update is a substantial revision to the model academic honesty policy, incorporating modern best practices and addressing the use of artificial intelligence programs.

j. MEMO 24-125 → BP 5141.43 Uniform Investigations **NEW POLICY**

i. This policy establishes a model investigative policy for professional boundaries violations. It does not supersede current investigatory procedures but provides best practices when conducting investigations under various existing policies. The new AR further develops best practices for conducting investigations set forth in the model investigations policy.

k. MEMO 24-126 → BP 6020 Parent Involvement

- i. AASB developed and distributed BP 6020 Parent Involvement to member school districts in 2016 in response to AS 14.03.016, A parent's right to direct the education of a parent's child. AS 14.03.016 requires school districts to have policies promoting the involvement of parents in schools. Among other provisions, it sets forth parental notification requirements for any activity, class, or program that includes content involving human reproduction or sexual matters.
- ii. The model policy was vetted by legal counsel and is a complete response to the provisions of AS 14.03.016. Adopting the model policy BP 6020 will help guide district operations appropriately and will help ensure your board policies align with state law.

I. MEMO 24-127 → BP 6112 School Day

i. This update includes a new provision that requires a kindergarten day in session to include at least two hours of instruction.

m. MEMO 24-128 → BP 6147 Alaska Reads Act Intervention Program **NEW POLICY**

i. This policy implements the reading intervention plans required by the new Alaska Reads Act. It addresses what must be included in the intervention program, individual reading plans, notification requirements, and progression goals.

n. MEMO 24-129 → BP 6148 Early Education Programs **NEW**

i. This policy implements the early education grant program under the Alaska Reads Act. It sets forth the compliance requirements for a district that opts for an early education grant under the Alaska Reads Act.

o. MEMO 24-130 → BB-9322 Agenda/Meeting Materials

This update adds a reference to State Statute, defines a timeline for board and public access to meeting materials, and adds a section for Board member preparation.
