	The Committee received a report from PBK Architects, retained by the Board of Trustees on August 13, 2015, to assist in the development of the site plan and improvements for the Public Safety Training Center. During the development of the site plan and estimation of costs for the construction of the facility, it was determined by PBK that a single-phase construction project would cost essentially the same as the previously contemplated two-phase construction approach because of the expected future construction cost increases. Additionally, the efficiency and effectiveness of instructional delivery would be enhanced by locating the Fire Science and Police Academy programs at a single location.
