Instructional Time

- We Currently have 173 Student Contact Days
 - More Than Most Districts 165 Days on Average
- 4 Canceled Days (1/11, 12/16, 12/15, 12/8)
- 3 2-Hour Delays (1/12, 1/9, 12/9)
- Instructional Time Lost
 - 29.2 Hours at SHS

Instructional Time

- Impacts of Cancellation and Delay
 - Direct Loss of Instructional Time
 - Less Material Covered
 - Classified Staff Loss of Work Time and Pay
 - Currently More than 4 Days of Work
 - 1 Day as Inclement Weather Day per Contract
 - Added PD Day on February 10th
 - No Impact on Teacher or Admin Pay

Instructional Time

- Oregon requires 900 hours in grades K-8 and we are currently scheduled to have a range of 916 (852) to 963 (905) at FCS
- Oregon requires 990 hours of instruction in grades 9-11 and we are currently scheduled to have over 1032 (974) for 9th grade and over 1026 (968) for grades 10 and 11
- Oregon requires 966 hours of instruction for grade 12 and we are currently scheduled to have over 988 (930) hours of instruction
- These calculations include 28 hours of parent teacher conferences and 30 hours of PD.
- They do not account for lost instructional time for non-academic assemblies

Instructional Time

- Possible Add Backs
- Add Days in June and Extend the School Year (11 – 12 hours)
- Make February 20th President's Day a full School Day (5.5 – 6 hours)
- Make April 13th a Full Day and April 14th a Full day (Parent Teacher Conferences the Evening of April 13th only) (8 to 9 hours)

Instructional Time

- Superintendent's Recommendation
 - February 20th Full Day
 - April 13th Full Day and April 14th Half Day with Conferences on the Evening of April 13th 3:30 to 8 and the Afternoon of April 14th 1:00 to 3:30
- This makes up 11 to 12 hours of the lost instructional time and gives our classified employees their lost work time back.
