

Pre-approval for Academic Club Reimbursement

Club - Student Council

Advisor - LeAnn Bolhuis

Criteria for Membership - Students grade 7-12 who are academically eligible

Club Goals and Objectives - To develop and provide opportunities for leadership and service in local school and in the community. To encourage personal growth of leaders through participation in activities that engage and benefit the students of Northome School.

It is expected that students council will host activities such as the following:

Open House

Support Fall Homecoming

Winter Homecoming

MCA Prep Week

Blood Drive

Halloween Activity

Thanksgiving Food Shelf

Winter Activity

Spring Carnival

And any other activity that student council votes on initiating. Every year will be based on student interest and engagement.

Budget -

- (1) Substitutes as needed for activities that occur during the school hours.
- (2) Advisor Salary - Level VI
- (3) Student Council fees due to Minnesota Association of Student Councils
- (4) Cost of decorations, incentives, materials, etc. for dances, pepfests, fundraisers, activities, etc. that occur over the course of the school year. This would include the above list.

Frequency of Meetings - Meetings will take place at least one time every two weeks throughout the school year with the entire Student Council. There will be an expectation that student council members commit to some after school, before school, evenings and weekend time. It is expected that there will be more than 30 meetings throughout the school year.

Number of Students Participating - Student council will be open to all students wanting to participate in grades 7-12. They will need to maintain a 90% attendance rate for meetings and events in order to qualify as a participating member. Typically, there are about 20 students in 7-12 who want to participate actively.

Advisor's Time - The advisor will be present at all meetings and the majority of the events and will put in time outside of the school day to accomplish the tasks required to make events successful. If the advisor is not present, someone will be appointed to stand in for the advisor.
