#### 2025-2026 District Goals

## Goal 1. Students and staff will thrive in a secure environment, build connections and community, and become resilient leaders.

## Strategy: Improve districtwide systems to ensure a safe environment through a centralized safety vulnerability prevention system.

- Conduct all campus safety audits to inform the centralized safety vulnerability prevention system by August 2026.
- Implement a new badging system for all bus riders by December 2025.
- Complete facility modifications of secondary restrooms by January 2026.
- Implement a CCISD Continuum of District Behavior Supports to align best practices and resources by January 2026.
- Conduct two cybersecurity preparedness exercises and develop response plans by May 2026.

#### Strategy: Build connections and community as measured through a Culture of Excellence Matrix.

- Develop the Culture of Excellence matrix by September 2025 to inform resources and support.
- Launch the districtwide ambassadorship program by October 2025 and track participation.
- Monitor usage of an online mentor-student platform monthly.
- Expand Leader in Me to four new schools and include a financial sustainability model by May 2026.
- Expand Clear2Lead with measurable results.

# Goal 2. Each student will engage in world-class learning experiences that foster curiosity, develop talents, guide exploration, and fuel achievement.

### Strategy: Improve instructional practices to achieve an 88 or higher score in Domain I of the A-F Accountability System.

- Implement Researched Based Instructional Strategies (RBIS) in literacy and math instruction, K-5 beginning in September 2025.
- Analyze student growth data in ELA, Math, and Science every nine weeks to inform and guide targeted academic interventions and enrichment strategies.
- Design and execute targeted academic improvement plans to close achievement gaps on priority campuses by September 2025.
- Assess the impact of instructional coaching and Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) on student achievement through rubric-based evaluations, stakeholder feedback, and analysis of academic performance data by May 2026.
- Increase the percentage of students/graduates who meet the Texas Success Initiative benchmarks in English Language Arts and Math through TSIA/TSIA2/ACT/SAT from 37.6% to 39.0%.

### Strategy: Promote innovation as measured by the creation of multiple new student learning opportunities.

- Develop and implement the success metrics for year one of the STREAM of Innovation Intermediate School program.
- Develop the STREAM of Innovation College Preparatory Program for the Fall of 2026.
- Implement year one of the PTECH program at Clear Horizons Early College High School.
- Create opportunities for non-core Dual Credit coursework for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Expand virtual learning options for high school students.

### Goal 3. CCISD will cultivate innovation through strategic collaboration and responsive organizational stewardship.

Strategy: Develop the Beyond Boundaries plan for student enrollment growth, facilities optimization, and financial stability.

- Create a timeline to optimize campus utilization and instructional programs by May 2026.
- Implement a district strategy for open enrollment including intentional marketing and student recruitment grounded in programs by September 2025.
- Establish a Facility Condition Index for each facility by August 2026.
- Complete Special Education and TASB staffing study to identify cost savings and efficiency options by February 2026.
- Provide recommendations for adoption of a balanced 2026-27 budget by May 2026.
- Advance the District's Teacher Incentive Allotment opportunities by May 2026.
