DESCRIPTION:

Attached is the bid tabulation for Buffalo High School Building Controls Replacement project showing the one company that placed a bid, along with a letter of recommendation from Hallberg Engineering to accept the base bid and reject Alternate #1.

The project scope is to eliminate the pneumatically actuated components that regulate HVAC equipment at the High School and replace them with digitally actuated components and wiring.
