Student Employees in Good Standing

The quality education of student employees remains the primary focus of the District. For student employees, school takes priority over employment. By extension, student employees are representatives of the District and shall be in good academic and behavioral standing.

In the event that a student employee is suspended from school, he/she may not work for the District during the time of their student suspension. Suspended students are not allowed on the school campus during the time of their suspension. Such absence from work may be considered unexcused and may affect their long-term employment status.

In addition, a student employee must be in good academic standing. If a student is failing any courses, they are to communicate with their supervisor that they may need to be removed from the work schedule to return their grades to a satisfactory level.
