

Food Service Report – May 2014

- As of May 15, 2014 we have brought in \$49,272.86 in Ala Carte Sales. We have spent \$22,581.78 showing a \$26,691.08 profit at this time.
- For May, we served a total of 6,977 breakfast meals vs 8,150 for last year and a total of 9,438 lunch meals vs 10,687 for last year at this time. We averaged 367 breakfast meals served per day and averaged 496 lunches being served per day.
- May 2nd – fixed 556 sack lunches for everybody at OES. They picked up the lunches and went outside for a picnic. (Spring Festival)
- May 7th – Kindergarten transition day. 16 students and 5 adults were Welcomed to OES and ate lunch with us
- May 8th PK – Mother’s Day Tea Party at OES. Prepared 8 dozen cookies for the Tea Party
- May 15th – 48 PK students went on a field trip. Breakfast was taken to the classroom.
- May 19th – Fixed Breakfast burritos for the Dyslexia Class going to San Angelo for a field trip (23 people attending)
- May 20th – 72 5th graders and 6 adults went on a field trip. Prepared 78 sack lunches
- May 22nd – 60 4th graders and 8 adults went on a field trip. Prepared 70 sack lunches
