Free/Reduced Meal Applications:

—NEW THIS YEAR: Apply online at LunchApplication.com

—Free and reduced meal applications to be in effect for the first day of school must be submitted by Thursday, August 29th, to allow us time to notify you of approval or disapproval. *There is no way to make the approval retro-active.*

—The federal government requires that we verify the income of 3% of the applications received, so please be accurate on your application as you may be asked to submit proof of income. **(turn applications into the Business Office)**

BREAKFAST & LUNCH INFO

-PLEASE SEND PAYMENT FOR MEALS ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

-Payments can be sent to either office or online through PaySchools Central. A link to PaySchools Central is on the school website. Please contact Leah in the business office with questions.

-Monthly bills with be mailed to accounts that have a balance owed. Payment is expected to be made immediately.

- Negative accounts for the previous year(s) must be paid before the first student day.
- Families that have not made any attempts to make their food service account current may be sent to a collection agency to recover funds.
- If students bring their own lunch and wish to purchase milk, or wish to purchase additional milk with their meal, the price is .35 per carton. If they don't bring exact change for their milk, their accounts will be charged .35 cents regardless of free/reduced status
- Federal nutrition standards state that students MUST take ½- cup fruit at breakfast and ½ cup fruit or vegetable at lunch for a reimbursable meal. If a student who received free/reduced
