Belmond-Klemme Graduation Rate

Graduation Rate Calculations:


The Department will report both a four-year and five-year cohort graduation rate. The four-year cohort graduation rate is calculated for the class of 2020 by dividing the number of students in the cohort who graduate with a regular high school diploma (numerator) in four years or less by the number of first-time 9th graders enrolled in the fall of 2016 minus the number of students who transferred out plus the total number of students who transferred in (denominator).

Laptops Have Begun Arriving

Four years ago, we were hard pressed to get the new laptops to our teachers and students. They did not arrive until the very end of summer, and right before the start of school. This year, because the school board was willing to approve the purchase well in advance, our new laptop computers have already begun arriving, and we will have plenty of time to process and asset tag them, set up their operating systems, install the new software, and get them ready to distribute. Teachers will have their new laptops before they leave on summer break.

Online Learners

Heading into the fourth quarter of the school year, our number of students remaining at home and doing all classes remotely continues to decline. For elementary students, we are now down to only five remote learners. In the secondary, we are at 14 students that use online learning as their primary access to education.

For next year, we will have two at-risk instructors, and we may use one of them to coordinate and instruct the online learners using a curriculum platform like the Odysseyware we use in Pat Kelley's Alternative Learning Center. Next August, one of our priorities will be getting our classrooms and teachers back to normal so teachers can focus on student achievement.


Bargaining Reminder: Contract Talks are Limited to the Team

Iowa Code 20.10 identifies prohibited practices under Iowa's collective bargaining law. Section 20.10(3)(j) states it is a prohibited practice for public employees or an employee organization to:

"Negotiate or attempt to negotiate directly with a member of the governing board of a public employer if the public employer has appointed or authorized a bargaining representative for the purpose of bargaining with the public employees or their representative, unless the member of the governing board is the designated bargaining representative of the public employer."

If any member of the school board gets contacted directly by a member of the Belmond-Klemme faculty regarding bargaining, contracts, salaries, or benefits, I would ask him or her to contact me.
