"Made a Difference" in some amazing kids.

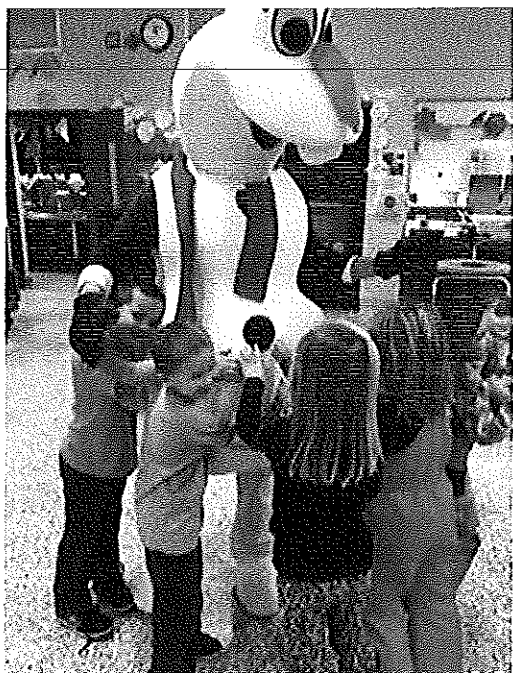
We planned & preped, decorated a bit and everyone
