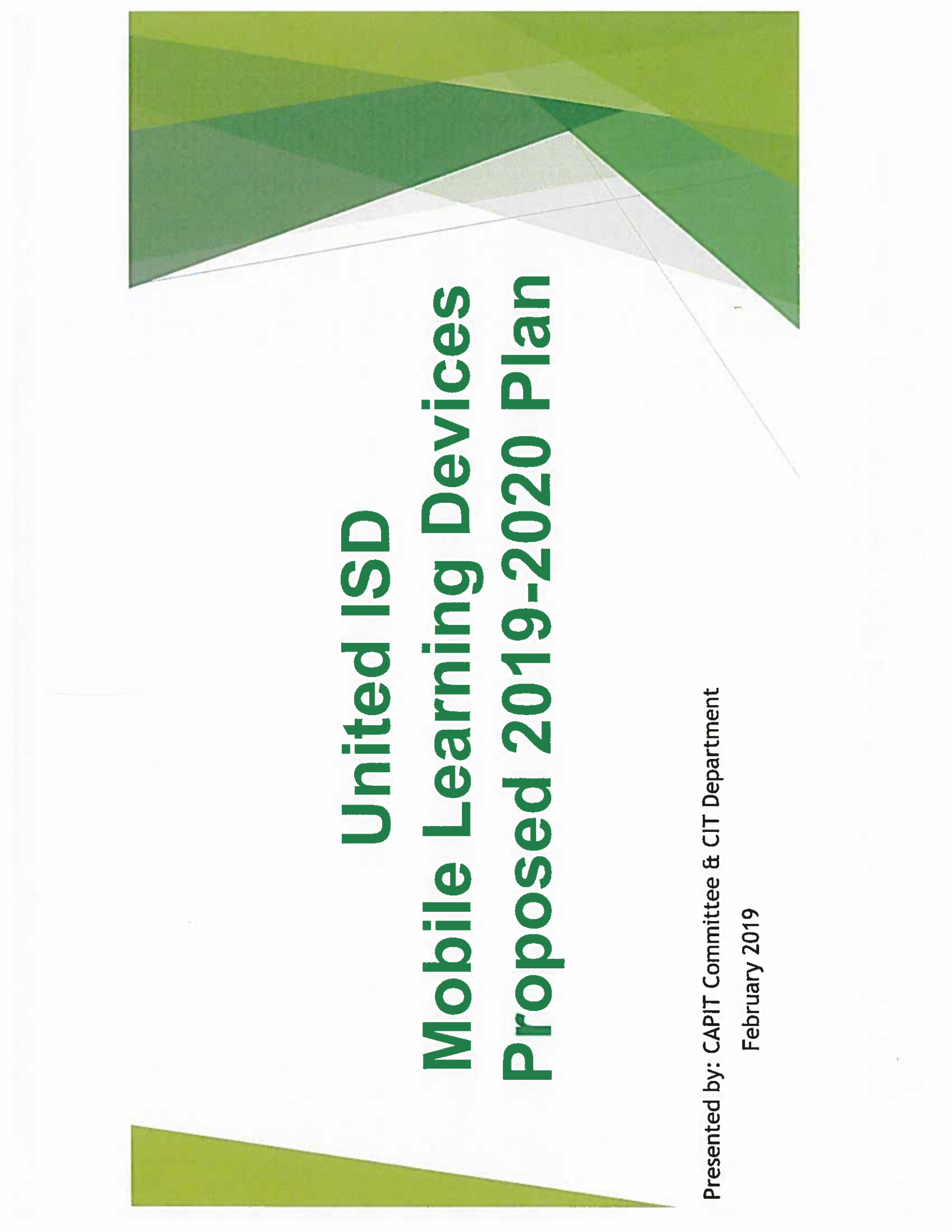

Elementary School Level

Existing Campus MLD Plan 2013-2014 to 2018–2019

- ▶ Full Size Teacher Apple iPad & 1 Safe with 7 iPad Mini's Student Devices
- ▶ Grade Pre-Kinder Full Size Teacher iPad
- ▶ Grade Kinder - 2nd Teacher and Student Devices
- ▶ Grades 3rd - 5th Chromebooks: Cart with 22 Student Devices in 3rd - 4th
Cart with 25 Student Devices in 5th

Proposed Campus MLD Plan 2019-2020

- ▶ Grades Pre K - 2nd Full Size Teacher iPads & Student iPad Carts
- ▶ Transfer Teacher iPads from 10 Middle Schools to 29 Elementary Campuses
- ▶ Device Distribution: Placed in designated grades Pre K - 2nd as per Elementary Executive Director's Plan

Middle School Level

Existing Campus MLD Plan 2013-2014 to 2018–2019

Apple iPads: Full Size Teacher iPad and Cart with 25 Full Size iPads

- ▶ Grade 6th Science Cart per classroom
- ▶ Grade 7th Science & Core Teacher Cart per Classroom
- ▶ Grade 8th Sci, Math, Social Studies, Reading Cart per Classroom
- ▶ Grade 8th ELA 1 Shared Cart
- ▶ 6th-8th SPED Resource Teacher iPad 1 Shared Cart
- ▶ SPED Units Safe with 4 Student iPads per Classroom

Chromebooks 25 per Cart

- ▶ Grades 6th - 7th Reading 1 Shared Cart
- ▶ Grades 6th - 8th ELA 2 Shared Carts

New Middle School

- ▶ Grades 6th - 8th iPads Science 1 Cart per class
- ▶ Grades 6th - 8th Chromebooks 1 Cart per class
- ▶ All STAAR, STAAR Support Classes, Art and Library

Middle School Level

Proposed Campus MLD Plan 2019-2020

- ▶ Apple iPad Reassignment
 - ▶ Grades 6th - 8th Reassign all iPads to Elementary PK - 2nd plus special initiatives that require iPads
- ▶ Carts 25 Chromebooks
 - ▶ Grades 6th - 7th STAAR and STAAR Support Class
 - ▶ Grades 6th - 7th Resource - Chromebook Cart per Teacher
 - ▶ Grade 8th Mainstreamed SPED Students 1:1
- ▶ 1:1 Student Devices (Quantity based on Enrollment)
- ▶ Device Deployment Plan
 - ▶ Chromebooks will remain at the campus at end of every school year
 - ▶ Checked out in August - Checked back in May to Librarian
- ▶ Intra Campus Transfers of iPads
 - ▶ 6th- 8th SPED Units for in-class use 1:1

High School Level

Campus MLD Plan 2013 - 2014 to 2018 - 2019

Apple iPads: Full Size Teacher iPad & Cart - 25 Student iPads

- ▶ Biology I Cart Per Class
- ▶ SPED Units Shared Cart

Chromebooks: Cart of 30 Chromebooks per class

- ▶ ELA I, ELA II, Reading, Social Studies, ESL, SPED

New 9th Grade Campuses

Chromebooks

- ▶ Algebra, English I and Reading Cart with 30 Devices per Class
- ▶ Art Shared Cart
- ▶ Foreign Language 2 Shared Carts

Apple iPads

- ▶ Biology

Transfer from Main Campus to 9th Grade Campus

Proposed Campus MLD Plan 2019-2020

High School Level - New 9th Grade Campuses

- ▶ iPad Reassignment
 - ▶ Biology iPads & Carts Move all to Elementary Grades Pk - 2nd and SPED Units in MS and HS
 - ▶ SPED Units Teacher Device and Shared Carts to provide up to 15 devices per classroom
- ▶ Chromebooks 9th Grade 1:1 Student Deployment
 - ▶ Distribute existing inventory and purchase balance to match enrollment
 - ▶ At the end of school year the devices will be transferred by IT to Main Campuses
 - ▶ Devices will follow a 4 year student cycle: Grades 9 - 12
 - ▶ Devices checked out every August and collected every May
- ▶ At the end of the 4 year cycle, different options will be considered, such as:
 - ▶ As inventory to replace lost or damaged student devices
 - ▶ Use for Testing or areas of need
 - ▶ Sell to students at a minimum cost
 - ▶ Gift Devices
