

# **Transportation/Maintenance Board Report 4/8/19**

I got a bid from Control Sentries to install networked direct digital controls for the middle school. This upgrade allows the thermostats to be remotely programmed and each HVAC unit monitored 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. This will allow us to set the temperature and program time for energy and gas savings. Control Sentries will monitor the system and notify us when a unit is not working properly.

This price is good for 60 days.

I applied to the State Department of Education-Student Transportation and received approval for Transfinder. Transfinder is a routing system for buses that tracks routes, stops and mileage. It also links with Lumen. The cost for this system is \$7,345 with an annual fee of \$3,350. I am waiting on the State for instructions going forward.

We did not receive a bid on repairing the track; they only gave a price on a new one. Track Doctor is coming out to it bid for repair. I will ask them if we don't repair now, what damage will it cause for next year.
