Baseball: The baseball team is 5-14 following a 8-6 win over Braham on Tuesday, May 17th. The boys close out their season on Tuesday, May 24th at home with a game against Aitkin which was rescheduled from earlier in the season. The Rangers also have an upcoming JV Tournament in Staples on Saturday, May 21st and a Junior High Tournament in Hill City on Saturday, May 21st. The Rangers will then start section playoffs on Tuesday, May 31st. The Rangers are coached by Bryan Syrstad, assisted by Mike Gindorff while the JV team is under the direction of Brady Sykora. Andrew Tuthill and Adam English lead the junior high squad.

The Rangers close out their regular season by hosting their Deacons Lodge Invitational on Wednesday, May 18th before competing at a Mid-Minnesota Invite on Monday, May 23rd and then travel to the Preserve Golf Course on Thursday, May 26th before opening up Section play on Tuesday, May 31st at Giants Ridge. The boys are coached by Rich Aulie and Brian Gaffney.
