General Note	s:		
1	Ensure that all Port-A-Johns are removed from the job site. Clean up all stray materials in all roof areas, paying special attention to roof screws left		
3	on roof. Check and seal all cracks or seams in existing copper flashing.		
Building I:

Building A:			
1	Around the higher circular portion of the roof, replace the flashing and repair the leak(s). Replace all damaged ceiling tile.		
2	EPDM flashing at Building A circle is raised. This area needs to be cut back at the southwest corner and sloped downward so that all water can drain properly. Re-seal.		
Building E:			
1	Check all caulk at the flashing at the low roof of Building E.		
Building F:			
1	There is a roof leak on the northeast side of this building. Water is coming in on the gym floor.		
3	Check all gas heaters for leaks around the collar. Reseal caulk at termination bar down to neoprene flashing strip at the northwest corner of Building F.		

This project may be considered substantially complete as of 2:00 pm on August 12, 2013.
