**AGENDA ITEM:** Discuss and consider approval of a

Memorandum of Understanding between Galveston Independent School District and Galveston College for College Preparatory

Courses.

In response to HB 5 legislation, under Section 28.014 of the Texas Education Code, each school district is required to partner with at least one institution of higher education to develop and provide college preparatory courses in English language arts and mathematics, generally for 12th grade students. Although there is not a specific requirement that a student must be in 12th grade to take a college preparatory course. However, a student may not earn credit for the college preparatory math course until after the student has completed the three mathematics credit requirements for the Foundation High School Program.

Galveston College and Galveston ISD work collaboratively to address the requirements for these courses, as outlined in the MOU.

**RECOMMENDATION:** I move that the Board of Trustees

approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Galveston Independent School District and

**Galveston College for College** 

**Preparatory Courses.**
