Out of Country World Language Trip Proposal - Spring Break 2017

French language instructors, Martha Behlow and Molly Shanahan, would like to request permission to organize a summer 2017 trip to France. The purpose of the trip is to provide an educational and cultural experience for our students that will reinforce and enhance their language abilities and cultural appreciation. It will provide students with the unique opportunity to experience and interact with people from France. The trip highlights include: Paris, major monuments, Palace of Versailles; TGV—high speed train to the south of France; Avignon, Nimes, Roman ruins including the Aquaduct the Pont du Gard; Les Baux, a medical fortress; Aix-en-Provence and Nice; and St. Paul de Vence, medieval town. - c. To provide students the opportunity to experience and interact with people from France through their participation in this activity.

Dear Principal Rogers, Dr. Mutchler, and Geneva School Board members,

We are respectfully requesting administration and school board approval to promote a trip to France during the 2017 spring break. My colleague Molly Shanahan and I would like to offer this trip to our Geneva High School French students.

This 9 day trip, titled Paris, Provence and the Riviera, would not require any additional days for students to be absent. The itinerary would concentrate on Paris and Provence, and area rich in cultural and historical traditions. Thanks to Julius Cesar and his Roman troops, there are many Roman ruins and amphitheaters still in existence, in some cases, in better shape than in Italy.

The company we are proposing to work with, WorldStrides, offers a combination of travel AND education to give our students the richest experience possible. In addition, and this was particularly intriguing to us, there is a 3 college credit option, at no additional cost, through San Diego State University, for those students who complete an online component upon our return.

The trip is priced at \$3939, but for those who would register prior to September 29, 2016, there is a \$300 early enrollment savings. In addition, there is a scholarship of \$400.00 price reduction for those whose family income is less than \$85,000 ...

DAY 1-2 FLY TO FRANCE. Overnight flight to Paris. Begin exploring France's answer to the "city that never sleeps".

DAY 3 DISCOVER PARIS. A local guide shows you the Arc de Triomphe, the Eiffel Tower, Champs-Elysées, and Les Invalides. Admire Notre Dame Cathedral from the inside out. Art lovers will delight in a visit to the enormous Louvre Museum. Tonight, enjoy breathtaking views from atop the Eiffel Tower.

DAY 4 VERSAILLES-MONTMARTRE. Travel to Louis XIV's decadent Palace of Versailles and en route, <u>Seize the Château!</u> Tour the immense Hall of Mirrors, the royal apartments and the gardens. DAY 5 TGV-AVIGNON-NIMES. Board the TGV for Provence. Stroll along the streets of Avignon and view the Pont St. Benezet, the 12th century bridge immortalized in a French nursery song. Later see the Pont du Gard, a Roman aqueduct. Marvel at the Roman buildings of Nimes: the Maison Carrée ("Square House") and the awesome Roman arena, the best preserved in France.

DAY 6 PROVENCE. Visit the medieval fortress of Les Baux. En Garde!

DAY 7 AIX-EN-PROVENCE. En route to Nice, visit the flowing fountains and charming locales of Aix-en-Provence. Enjoy Painters' Provence. In the evening, enjoy a walking tour of Vieux Nice.

DAY 8 ST. PAUL DE VENCE-CUISINE PROVENCALE Enjoy an excursion to the medieval town of St. Paul de Vence. Later, cook up <u>Cuisine Provencale</u>. Please note, dinner is not included today.

DAY 9 RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES, or opt to extend your stay in France with adding extra days in Nice.
