1. *How many schools does District 90 have? Please list the school's name, the year it was built, its enrollment size, and the grade levels of each school.*

Response: 3 schools – (1952) Lincoln Elementary School K-4, 360 students, (1929) Willard Elementary School Pre-K-4, 347 students, (1923) Roosevelt Middle School 5-8, 633 students.

2. *What is the ratio of student to teacher at each school?*

3. *How many students are enrolled in the special education program at each school?*

Response: Yes. Lincoln Elementary School – 409; Willard Elementary School – 548; Roosevelt Middle School South Gym – 552; Roosevelt Middle School North Gym – 1,001.

7. *Does each school offer specials (ex: art, foreign language, gym, and music)? When offering these specials, is there an assign classroom or is the teacher traveling from classroom to classroom?*

Response: Yes. Specials have assigned classrooms. Specials vary by school level. Please refer to our website at www.district90.org.


