## Program Purpose:

- 1. The Title 1-Migrant program in the Homedale School District addresses the special educational needs of migrant children by providing educational support services. This will be accomplished through a coordinated, integrated and quality program. Our goal is to overcome barriers of education caused by repeated moves and ensure that migrant children are able to meet the same content and performance standards as all children.
- 2. The migrant program will also provide an advocacy and outreach, professional development, family literacy, and transition of secondary students to post-secondary education.
- 3. Priority will be given to migrant children who are failing or most at risk of failing and whose regular school year education has been interrupted. These students will meet the state's content and performance standards.
- 4. The migrant education program is designed to supplement, but not supplant the regular classroom curriculum and ensure that children will function successfully in the regular classroom.
- 5. The Home School Coordinator will recruit and identify all eligible migrant children within the Homedale School District.
- 6. All State and Federal regulations will be followed.
