Good evening everyone! I hope your summer is going well. My report is a bit short due to the summer time so I apologize.

Report

- The custodial and maintenance staff, along with some Denfeld students who have been hired to help this summer, have been hard at work cleaning and preparing the school for the upcoming school year.
- Summer School at Denfeld is wrapping up next week which will open up the rest of the building to be cleaned and reset for next year.
- 19 students attended the Close Up Program in Washington, DC during the week of June
 19 to learn more about our government and how to be engaged citizens.
- Our Summer DASH program has been operating daily through our Full Service
 Community School serving between 5 and 15 kids depending on the day. Students
 participate in activities that are based in creating resiliency by connecting to the
 outdoors, positive experiences and relationship building. The program brings in
 community partners like UMD for STEM activities and Planned Parenthood. It is aligned
 with the summer school calendar to provide activities, tutoring and an opportunity to
 make up time required for summer school.
- Denfeld hosted the district wide Indian Education Enrichment Program for secondary students. 20 students participated in a variety of cultural activities including ribbon skirt making, drum making, traditional lacrosse, and college visits to Northwood and Fond du Lac Community Colleges. The program culminated with a trip to Red Cliff and Madeline Island learning about the tribal fishery program, tribal food sovereignty, music and storytelling from Frank Montano, and visited the burial site of Chief Buffalo and discussed treaty rights.
- School staff have been completing a lot of data entry from the 21-22 school year to both close the books on last year as well as use the data, including the school climate survey, for planning the 22-23 school year.
