### **Kindergarten**

This month is math we will continue to learn all about numbers 11-15. We will now be adding and subtracting numbers up to 10. In reading, we will continue to review story elements such as characters, setting, and key events. We will also continue to identify the main idea of a story and using story maps to retell a story. In writing, we will be working on writing a narrative story using pictures and/or 1-2 sentences. In science we will be exploring our weather unit. In social studies we will be exploring geography and places. This means, Christmas around the world!!!

# First Grade

We recently learned to use transition words in a text and that they support the beginning, middle and end of a story. This month we will continue writing a lot. We are especially excited about the letters for Santa! In Reading the new topic for this month will be long and short vowels where we will learn how to identify them in a word and how to apply them when we are reading. For Conventions we will keep working on adverbs. In December, we will start a new math unit, we will focus on 10 less and 10 more of a number and we will work on skip counting forward and backwards. Finally, for Social Studies we will identify and describe physical characteristics of places that affect the way of living in your community; and in science we will focus on weather, natural resources and bodies of water.

# Second Grad

In Math we will be learning about fractions and continuing to explore addition and subtraction. Our second grade scientists will discover natural and man-made resources, and in Social Studies we will learn about local, state, and federal government. Our kids will be working hard in ELAR as well, this month they will be describing main characters and story elements. In addition to all of our academic activities our 2nd graders have been preparing for their Christmas Musical
