o are accepted by the advisor through election by class members or through application
0 are not failing any classes ("C" average)
o have a pattern of acceptable behavior, which means they are not breaking school rules where they have to serve detention and ISS repeatedly
o apply for the position by filling in a self-nomination form which includes a teacher recommendation

## 4. Some Goals and Objectives:

o To promote student leadership and responsibility
o To conduct business in a democratic manner (parliamentary procedure)
o To provide an opportunity for representative government
o To plan, raise funds, and carry out school activities to enhance school spirit
o To learn entrepreneurial skills by running the school store

6. Planned Club Activities:
o Elect officers
o Conduct regular meetings about twice a month
o Learn some parliamentary procedure to use in our meetings
o Attend regional/state workshops or conventions to improve leadership skills
o Possibly sponsor a social event or an assembly
o Hold fundraisers for activity fund and for service projects
o Run the school store, learn about handling money
o Assist with other school activities to improve school climate
7. Frequency of Meetings: Meetings will usually be held at least twice a month during lunch hour or after school for a total of at least 25 meetings during the year.
8. Number of Students: The ideal is to have at least two from each grade, $6 / 7-12$. This year I have offered that if there are more than two the others can be alternates and participate.
9. Outside Activities: Outside of the school day, I will be involved in Student Council meetings, Frost Fests and other holiday events, going to workshops/division meetings/state conferences, supervising the school store, and coordinating after-school activities such as training, special programs, dances or fundraisers. I am not sure if we will be attending the fall leadership event and the State Conference; it depends on who is on the Council and their level of commitment and if the dates work out. Both events are included in the budget. If we do not go to the fall event, we may consider sponsoring a special presenter at Indus or in conjunction with the NE division during the year.
