Information

Each school district in Texas is required in Chapter 28.004 of the Texas Education Code to establish and maintain a district-level School Health Advisory Council. The School Health Advisory Council of the Dumas Independent School District is specifically authorized by the Board of Trustees in District policies BDF (Legal), BQ (Legal), EHAA (Legal), EHAC (Legal), EFAA (Legal), and FFA (Local). In addition, the SHAC is required to:

- Meet at least 4 times per year
- Contain a minimum of 5 members – majority of which are parents who are not employed by the district
- Report to the school board at least once annually with a detailed account of SHAC activities and recommendations
- Appoint parent as chair or co-chair
- Recommend indicators for evaluating effectiveness of Coordinated School Health programs
