See attached Employee Health and Benefits Consulting Agreement. The agreement relates to required and needed services. This service is an integrated component of District's self-insured Heath and life insurance benefit program costs.

Funding Source and Contract Amount:

Account code 100.000.000.000.718 in the amount of \$40,000.

Available Budget:

This is a minor component of the overall health and life insurance cost allocated and recorded as expenditure by payroll during processing. \$7,449,170 in FY2023 Health and Life Fringe Benefits for FY2023 is included in the proposed budget is available.

Grant Funds:

The respective contract does contain or relate to any grant funds.

Compliance with BP 3311:

The School District has conducted business with Marsh and McLennan for many years, The level of service provided has met the expectations of the Board and the School District. Marsh and McLennan has demonstrated specialized understanding of this complex field of insurance and the services provided exceed the financial obligation for such contract.
