TOPIC: Approval to Purchase Computers for Livonia Career Technical Center

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 27 HP single unit computers with HP Care Pack coverage for the Livonia Career Technical Center, as awarded through REMC pricing to CDW-G, for a total expenditure of \$59,913.

RATIONALE:

These computers will replace aging computers that are utilized in the Computer Repair and Security course and the Internet Engineering course. This purchase ensures that LCTC programs match college-level and industry-standard technologies.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The funding source for this purchase will be from the 61a/Added Cost allocation provided by the State of Michigan. This purchase will be fully funded outside of the LPS operating budget.
