BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In an effort to reduce costs in non-instructional areas, we have been looking at the possibility of implementing a two-tier bus system for next school year. The system would be set up so that all elementary school students would be transported separately from all of the other students.

There are three primary benefits from implementing such a system.

- 1. It would save the district money because we would require fewer busses, thereby not having to buy new busses as often.
- 2. It would separate the elementary students from the older students.
- 3. It would allow us to be better able to attract individuals to become bus drivers because although we would require fewer drivers, those drivers would work more hours and therefore be paid more per day.
