**AGENDA ITEM:** Consider Approval of Construction Manager At-Risk

PRESENTERS: Dan Manning, Superintendent

**ALIGNS TO BOARD PRIORITY(S):** FINANCIAL/FACILITIES- the District shall exhibit excellence in financial and facility planning, management, and stewardship.

## **Background Information:**

- At the May 20<sup>th</sup> Board meeting, the Board approved Construction Manager At-Risk as the procurement method to be used for the proposed projects at the Learning Center and High School. Here is the process we have been following:
- Beginning May 21<sup>st</sup>, the District posted RFQ advertisements on the web site and in the Community News. There were 7 companies who responded.
- **June 5th**–our selection committee (*including Board member Steve Bartley, CFO Earl Husfeld, and Supt. Dan Manning*) went through all 7 construction company applications and selected the top 3 companies to be interviewed on June 10<sup>th</sup>.
- June 10<sup>th</sup>-the Committee interviewed the top 3 potential construction companies.
- **June 13<sup>th</sup>** the Committee met to review the fee proposals received from the 3 construction companies interviewed, discussed and to rank the 3 companies based on established criteria, such as cost of services, reputation, experience, and quality of services.
- **June 17<sup>th</sup>** Board meeting Tonight, we are proposing the Board approve the selection committee's recommendation of Construction Manager.

## **Administrative Considerations:**

- At the end of the process we have described, and based on the rankings we
  established, the committee believes that Buford Thompson Construction will be
  the best choice for us to use as our Construction Manager At-Risk for these
  projects and to enter into negotiations to finalize a contract.
- With approval tonight of the Construction Manager, **prior to the July 22**<sup>nd</sup> Board meeting, our Architect, Construction Manager, and district staff will determine final design and cost estimates of these projects.
- July 22<sup>nd</sup> Board meeting the Board will consider approval of final design and costs of projects.

## **Fiscal Notes:**

The cost of the projects will be paid for with remaining 2008 bond funds.

<u>Administrative Recommendation</u>: Administration recommends the approval of Buford Thompson Construction as the top ranked Construction Manager At-Risk for the proposed Aledo Learning Center expansion and the front entrance remodel of Aledo HS.
