Evergreen Elementary School is a Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS) school. We have 4 simple rules that we ask students and staff to follow; Be Safe, Be Responsible, Be Respectful and Be Kind. Each month we celebrate with our students for observing these expectations with a PBIS assembly. Last month we had our first out-door PBIS assembly. Some of our community members stepped up in a big way for our kids and brought in a trick horse for the kids and St. Bernards that pulled some students around on a cart. Every month every student is invited to our PBIS assembly. The goal is to remain invited throughout the month. How do they do it? Students who have not received an office referral, a bus citation or more than 2 redirection room slips are invited. Students stay on the invite list by following our 4 school rules. Sometimes we all make mistakes, which is why every month students start with a clean slate and are invited to that month's assembly.

2011/2012 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS

Straight Line Routes For:

Illinois Valley, Lorna Byrne, Evergreen

In the event of adverse weather conditions parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJO, KLDR, KBOY and TV Stations KOBI (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the 3 Rivers School District Web Page for information on school bus schedules.

Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

When straight line routes are run the roads affected are listed below.

If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you may bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road traveled. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off.
