Smarter Balanced Assessment

Once again our 3rd-5th graders will be taking the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBAC) in the spring. If you would like to opt-out of your child taking this test, you will need to go to the district website and fill out the opt-out form and submit it to the school by April 1st. Testing windows for ELA, math, science, in April and May, dates to be determined. More information will follow.
