Absences: Not more than 14 in a school year. Please call the office at 541-476-8284 if you are going to be absent. The following letters will be sent out after multiple absences. School related absences (sports, clubs, suspensions, etc) does not apply to absences.

- LETTER 1: **Notification of Truancy** (4 or more days unexcused in a 4 week period)
- LETTER 2: **Letter of Concern** (4 or more total absences per year any reason)
- LETTER 3: **Excessive Absences 1** (7 or more total absences per year any reason)
- LETTER 4: **Excessive Absences 2** (10 or more total absences per year any reason)
- LETTER 5: **Excessive Absences 3** (14 or more total absences per year any reason)
