Most of our initial testing has been completed at Priest Lake Elementary!

Our staff have been hard at work identifying the needs of the individual students based on the data below. The official testing data for AMIRA was not available at this time, as the testing window closes at the end of October.

The EasyCBM Data is used to help the teachers identify areas of weakness for students and help them work on the skills they need to get to grade level proficiency.

EasyCBM is used for all students K-6 for both reading and math, whereas AMIRA is used for reading and only for K-3.

AMIRA Data

Please note this is interim testing data not actual state reported scores. The official scores will be available at the end of October

A score of Tier 1 means that students are at or above grade level for reading. Tier 2 means that they are near grade level. Tier 3 means that they are below grade level. The majority of our students did very well, with only 2 needing more severe intervention. There were some technology problems, so these scores are pending change at the end of the official scoring window this month.

As you can see from the above data, very few students are posing a high risk of being below grade level in reading with over 72% having no risk at falling behind and only 1 student is high risk. Math is far better with 80% of students having no risk and 3 students being high risk. Thanks to the testing the high risk and moderate risk students are receiving targeted instruction to help them succeed.

On October 6th we completed fire drill #2. There were no issues with the radios this time and the students evacuated in a total time of 41 seconds! They did a great job knowing the procedures! I think that time will be very hard to beat in the following drills, especially considering the changing weather.

November 10th will be the Veterans Day assembly at PLE at 10:00 AM. All veterans in the community are welcome to attend! The students have been working very hard on being able to sing and play songs to help honor all of our Veterans!

The first PTO Meeting on September 24th went very well! We identified several needs of our students that are being addressed! One of the biggest ones are the bussing issues with students at PLE and the total time that some students ride the bus every day. PLEF is working with the district and myself to remedy the issue.
