

Creating a New Club

Any teacher or student having an interest in starting a new club may obtain a Proposal Form (see following pages) in the District Office. After the completed form has been returned to the District Office, the application goes through the following process:

1. Review of the application by the Building Principal in light of the above criteria for school-sponsored clubs and conditions for school-recognized club.
2. Meeting with employee, potential sponsor and/or students and the Building Principal.
3. Final written decision by the Building Principal.
4. If a club is accepted as a school-sponsored club, the club will be on "pilot" status for two full semesters and a specific plan to start as a school-sponsored pilot club will be developed by the employee, sponsor, and students.
