

Immunization Notice

For the 2012/2013 school year there is an additional vaccination requirement. The 7th and 8th grade students need one dose of Tdap if it has been at least five years since receiving their last Tetanus containing vaccine. The state mandated EXCLUSION DATE for this 2012/2013 school year is set for Wednesday, **February 20, 2013**.

Beginning on Wednesday, February 20th, your child <u>will not</u> be allowed back at school until she/he returns with a copy of the updated immunization record. If you have any questions, the Josephine County Health Dept. is open Monday through Friday; you may reach them @ 541-474-5325. Or you can call Debbie @ 541-862-2171.

After updating your child's shot records please send a copy to the LSMS office.



An Invitation to Apply for Appointment to the Three Rivers School District Board of Education

The Three Rivers School District Board of Education invites all interested patrons to apply for a vacant Zone 2 position on the Board of Education. The Board will appoint the new member to fill an unexpired position with a term to run from February 11, 2013 to June 30, 2013. They may file to run for this position in the next May election. The new board member will be selected from the list of applicants.

To be eligible for appointment the candidate must:

- 1) Live in Zone 2 Precinct (the Hidden Valley attendance area which encompasses the Hamilton, Robertson, Jerome Prairie, New Hope and Slate Creek Precincts;
- 2) Lived in the district at least one-year immediately preceding the election;
- 3) Not an officer or employee of the School District; and
- 4) Be a qualified voter of the School District.
