- Met with local school districts and Region 16 regarding the planning for shared CTE pathways for the 25-26 school year. The intended shared pathways will be Health Science, Diesel, and Welding. This will allow FPC to offer more courses for our service area due to the shared pathways.
- Dr. Carroll, Michele, and Christy attended a TEAMS meeting with the Windham staff regarding the next step in the process for the TDCJ students. They are completing our official MOU. We will have regular meetings with them to plan and prepare for the start-up. Dr. Carroll and Christy also attended a virtual presentation from Windham School District. It was highly informative.
- Advanced EMT is going well. We have ten students.
- Christy has ordered the EMT Equipment that was purchased through TRUE Grant funds.
- Cassi, Jennie, and Christy met regarding company CDL procedures and fees.
- Met with all four school counselors regarding the new TSI guidelines for dual credit.
- We set up dates to go meet with the students at the four schools regarding courses for next year.
- We will administer the TSI exam for the 10th grade students at Dalhart High School on March 17th.
- Our first Spring Semester group of ESL and GED students have completed their courses. We offered five different language acquisition levels for our students. This proved to be successful. Several GED students have passed their exams and earned their GED.
- We will offer classes for both GED and ESL after Spring Break.
- Our campus has hosted CE courses for Hilmar, UP, DHCHD, TCOLE, and XIT Communications over the past few weeks.
- Phlebotomy class is going well, and the students are progressing along.
- Our staff plans to attend the Dalhart Career Fair in April.
- Our campus has started recruitment for the Summer Semester.
