Recommendation:

Background and Rationale:

The goal for the Title V project is to increase the completion, persistence and transfer rates of students, particularly Hispanic students and First Time in College (FTIC) students, through the creation of a Career and Transfer Center. The Center includes a career-themed summer bridge program focusing on goal formation, career choice, and financial literacy. Additional components include proactive advisement, career exploration, alternative pathways, and internship/apprenticeship opportunities. A virtual online presence for the Center will be created. On October 1, 2022, the project begins the third year of a five-year project.

Cost and Budgetary Support: \$600,000.00 in Year 3 (October 1, 2022-September 30, 2023)
No cost to the College. Grant funds will be deposited for expenditure from the Current Restricted Fund.






