Principal's General Narrative:

Teachers and students have been working diligently to accomplish the things we need to do for success in STAAR and EOC areas as well as other classes.

Junior High athletes have been doing well in their various sports. As they come to a close in cross-country, volleyball, and football competitions the athletes will be preparing for the basketball season. Coaches have been doing a good job with athletes.

Junior High tutorials have been taking place on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 3:45 p.m. until 5:30 p.m. since October 2, 2012. Attendance by students has been growing each week as they come in to work on the core subjects and do what they need to do in other subjects as well.

We have made progress in the lunchroom with the combining of sixth through eighth grades in one cafeteria, more students bringing in permission forms for the Biometric System (fingerprint accounting) program being used at the cafeteria register, and the flow of students through the lunch setting.

The BISD maintenance department has been keeping the facilities in good shape and tending to problems with A/C, plumbing, and other issues that have come up. They will be installing lockers for the sixth grade when it will not interfere with the daily education of the junior high students. They will have to use an air hammer to install the lockers and it makes so much noise that it will interfere with teaching.
