Background Information

To guide the improvement of student performance, the district and each campus continuously review, rate, and revise the progress of their improvement plans. Advisory committees at both the campus and district levels are composed of teachers, staff, district administrators, parents, business representatives, and community members. The planning process is guided by established Board Policy and Texas state statute, and the planning format includes all components required by the Texas Education Agency.

The District Improvement Plan focuses on four goals, with performance objectives that document the path to achieving each of these goals. The goals have evolved to reflect a more student-centered focus. The goals identify how we will implement, monitor, and examine growth in each of four primary ideals: Academics, Culture, Leadership, and Advocacy. Goal 1, Academics, includes the House Bill 3 Early Childhood literacy, math, and College, Career, and Military Readiness goal requirements as well as strategies that pertain to House Bill 4545/HB1416. The MAST committee will work throughout the school year to examine the progress made toward each goal and make recommendations for continued improvement.
