Subject: Reinstate Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Testing Fee

Recommendation: Approve Reinstating EMS Testing Fee, Effective January 1, 2026

## **Background and Rationale:**

Previously, the EMS Program used EMS Testing to prepare students for the National Registry Exam. The EMS program recently adopted textbooks with a new publisher that does not include EMS Testing. The new publisher includes a test preparation application, but it does not provide analytics and evidence to support its success. EMS Testing is a proven platform with excellent analytics to guide student preparation. It also has excellent classroom applications and will help students determine subject matter in which to focus additional study time. The request is to add student course fees to cover the cost of the EMS Testing Platform as shown below:
