Background Information:

Stantec has been working in conjunction with the Administration to develop a schematic design for the new K-8 Campus. This project was approved by the board earlier this school year. The Elementary School No. 10 campus will serve approximately 750-800 students. It will be a modern design with functional capacity to address the needs of all learners in both individual and group settings.

Fiscal Implications:

The estimated construction budget is \$21,000,000.00. These funds are allocated in the 2019 bond.
