The digital billboard at northbound exit 131 is now advertising all businesses in the BDA district throughout the year. Feedback has been positive and several featured businesses are expressing their appreciation.

BDA staff and City of Clio staff are partnering to hold our second annual Small Business Workshop on April 16th from 5:30 – 7:30 pm at the Clio Fire Department. Speakers include representatives from MEDC, SBDC, Metro Community Development, Sequelle HR Suite, and Guiles Media.

The 2026 Property Improvement Grant and Landscaping Grant are now online and advertised via Facebook and Constant Contact.
