Email is to be used primarily for:

- Teacher-student correspondence
- Accessing/submission of classroom assignments or materials





 All email is monitored and filtered at all times

 Students should not expect their email to be private.

Follow the Denton ISD Student Code of Conduct when online.

If it's not acceptable in the classroom, it's not acceptable online.



Never give out personal information.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)









Participation of BYOD is at the discretion of campus administration and/or classroom teachers.









Students who use web-enabled devices from home will have access to the filtered, wireless DISD-PUB network but will not have access to any district printers or district drives such as network folders.











I just can't get my laptop to connect to the network. Can I get some help from someone?
