What is Title One?

- Title 1-A is the United States Government's largest education assistance program for schools.
- Funds are used to provide programs to help children who are struggling in reading and math.
- Extra help (in addition to what they learn during math and reading time in the classroom)
- Funding is provided under ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act)

Annually we will make available the following opportunities for parent involvement:

- During our annual Fall Open House, current Title One information will be given out.
- We will host Fall and Spring events to bring families to campus.
- We will invite parents/guardians to participate in the creation of the School/Parent/Student Compact at a Spring Site Council meeting.

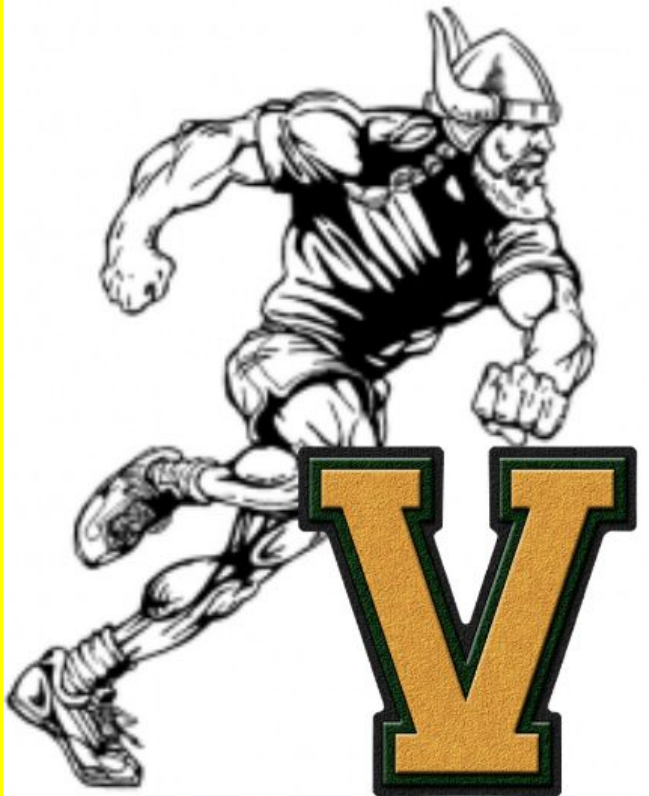
