## TASB Policy Update 94

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### **Purpose of Report**

Update 94 is a special update to address the requirement for districts to adopt local policy for the care of students with a diagnosed food allergy who are at risk for anaphylaxis, as required by SB 27 from the 82nd Legislative Session. SB 27 requires districts to adopt local policy by August 1, 2012, and the local policy must be based on the *Guidelines for the Care of Students with Food Allergies At-Risk for Anaphylaxis* developed by the Texas Department of State Health Services.
